The Quilting Ministry is hosting Coffee And this Sunday, March 19th in honor of National Quilting Day.

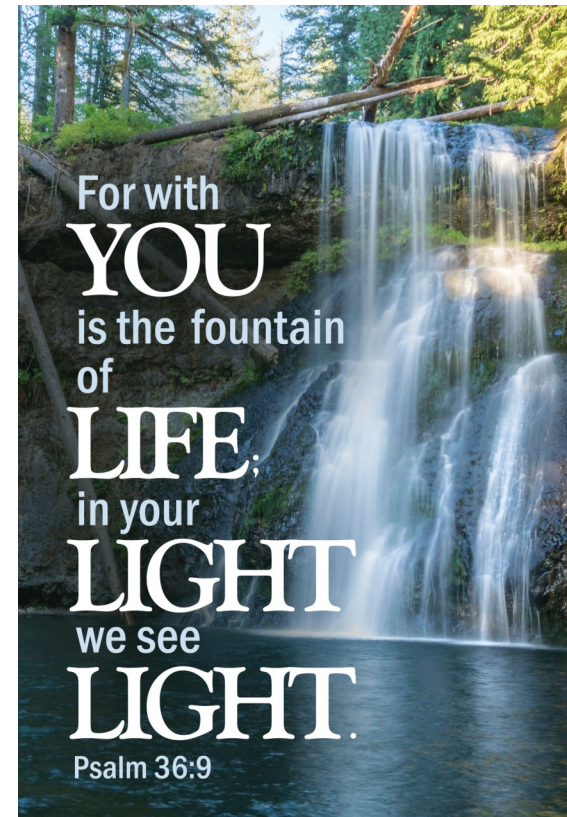
Grab a cup of coffee and some goodies, and check out some of the quilts we have made, as well as other charity sewing church members have been working on.
