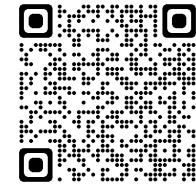

✝ For the family and friends of Pastor Patricia Gibson, following her death last week.

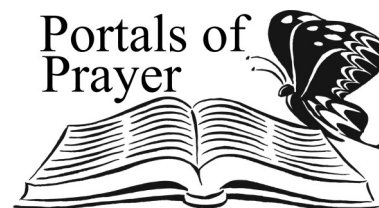
