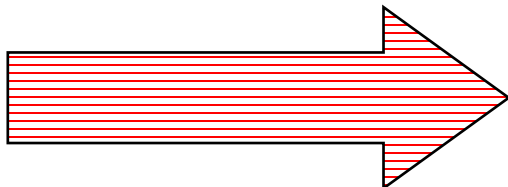

**Volunteers are needed in the following areas:**

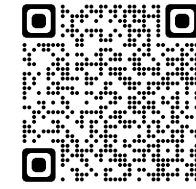
\*Vehicle decoration group - needs to be here at Zion at 7:30am and will have about an hour to get this accomplished.
