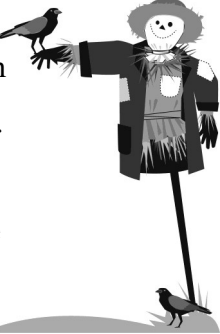

Due to the size of the frames, clothing should be teenage or adult size. No children’s size clothing, please.

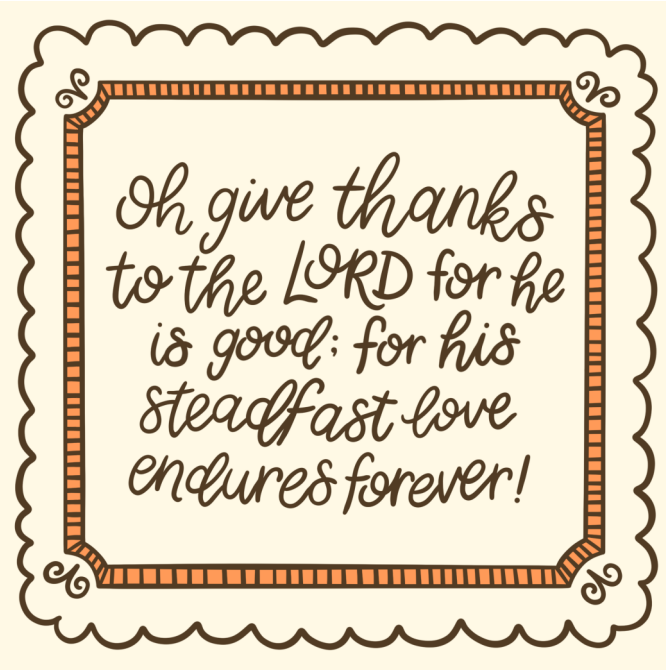
Here's how you can help us re-stock the scarecrow closet!

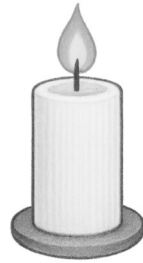
