WISH LIST:

- **Safety pins** to hold outfits together
- **Yarn or string** to tie off pants and sleeves
- **Hats** - men's, ladies, kids, straw, cowboy, farmer, baseball, hard hat, military, fire, police, clown, chefs
- **Veils**, scarves, shawls, ponchos, capes
- **Purses** with shoulder straps
- **Tops** - long sleeve or short,

sports/team, tie dyed, hoodies, sweaters, blouses

- **Pants** - jeans, sweats, jeggings, lounge, cargo, capris
 - Ties and/or vests
 - Prom dress or gowns
 - PJs, nightgowns
 - Wigs
 - **Costume jewelry** - necklaces, beads, big pins
 - **Shiny or dressy** fabric, tulle, and sheer curtains that can be cut up to make tutus, veils and superhero capes. Please bag these separately and bring them to the church by Sept. 3rd so we have time to re-make them into garments.
 - Permanent markers (colored) for drawing facial features.
 - **Flowers** - plastic or fabric
- We don’t need sheets or plastic jugs at this time.

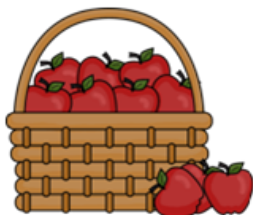
