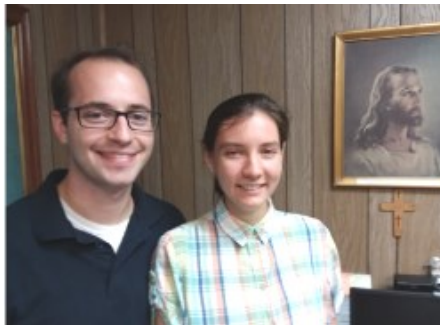

The project schedule is as follows:

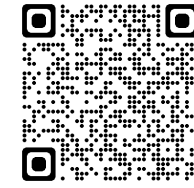
April: Information is being provided about the project.
