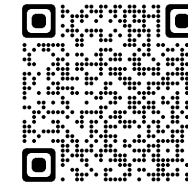

The box is for bottles/cans only, please no trash.

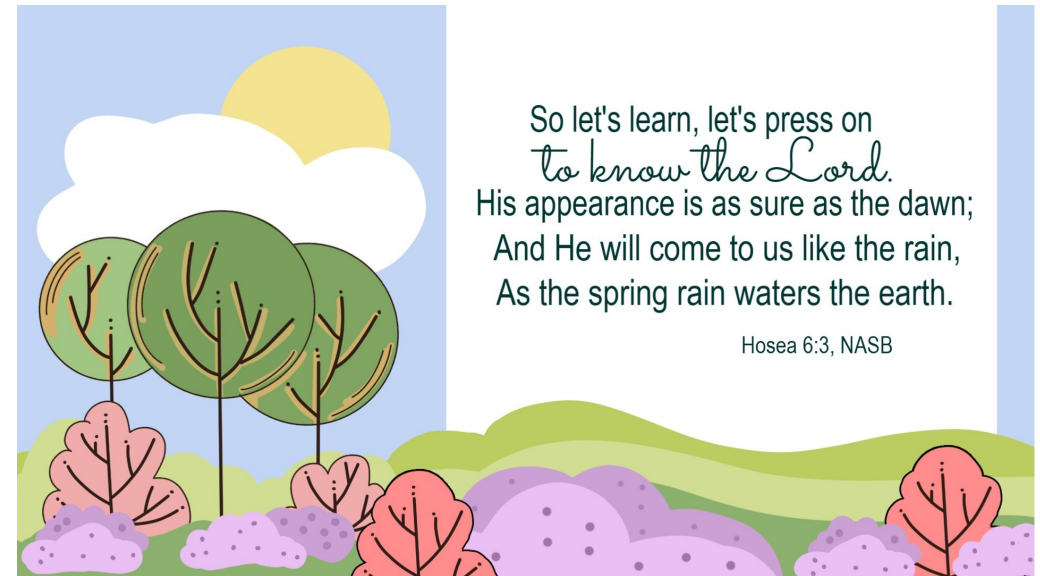
